Club Info:

The **KS1 Club** will continue to run each Monday throughout the school year; the sports will include football, cricket, athletics, archery/fencing and others too, having a designated night will enable the children to be able to play these sports with children of their own age. The **KS2 Club** will run on the same basis but on a Tuesday night. These clubs will be run by coaches supplied by Andy Gledhill and Project Sport, as will the Dance club on Wednesdays.

Draw Me a Story. This club will continue. Fancy designing some happy shoes for grumpy feet? Or maybe creating a breath taking view to help HaliTosis the dog? Picture books are a powerful starting point for discussing ideas and inspiring creative thinking for all ages. They spark the imagination, extend vocabulary and understanding and encourage learning. Club Expectations

By encouraging extra-curricular activities we intend to:

- Enable children to experience different physical activities
- Provide opportunities for fun and enjoyment through a range of activities
- Extended learning through particular activity area
- Encourage children to work together cooperatively and across age groups

Behaviour

Whilst attending Clubs, children are expected to:

- Use socially acceptable behaviour.
- Respect one another, accepting differences of race, gender, ability, age and religion
- Choose and participate in a variety of activities.
- Ask for help if needed.
- Enjoy their time at the Club.

Positive behaviour is encouraged by:

- Staff acting as positive role models.
- Praising appropriate behaviour

Dealing with inappropriate behaviour

- Challenging behaviour will be addressed in a calm, firm and positive manner.
- In the first instance, if necessary, the child will be temporarily removed from the activity.
- Staff will explain why the behaviour displayed is deemed inappropriate.
- Staff will encourage and facilitate mediation between children to try to resolve conflicts through discussion and negotiation.
- Staff will consult with parents to formulate clear strategies.

If after consultation with parents and the implementation of behaviour management strategies, a child continues to display inappropriate behaviour, the Club may decide to exclude the child. The reasons and processes involved will be clearly explained to the child and their parent/carer.
